

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF DESERONTO

BY-LAW 11-89

A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND PROHIBIT THE SETTING OFF OF FIREWORKS AND THE SALE OF FIREWORKS IN THE TOWN OF DESERONTO


WHEREAS Paragraph 30 and 31 of Section 210 of the Ontario Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, as amended, provides that a By-Law may be passed by the Council of a local municipality to regulate or prohibit the setting off and sale of fireworks and fire-crackers in the municipality;


NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Deseronto ENACTS as follows:

1. That the setting off of fireworks and firecrackers is hereby prohibited in the Town of Deseronto at any time other than on the days proclaimed for the observance of Victoria Day and Canada Day, or pursuant to a permit obtained from the Town Clerk, and every display so authorized shall be carried out only under the supervision of a "Fireworks Supervisor" from the Fire Department of the said Town of Deseronto.
2. That the sale of fireworks and firecrackers is hereby prohibited in the Town of Deseronto at any time other than during the period of ten days immediately preceding and including the time mentioned in Paragraph 1. of this by-law and then only to any person 18 years of age and over.
3. That any person convicted of a breach of any provision of this By-Law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the Provincial Offences Officer, a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs) the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each offence.
4. By-Law Number 1347 is hereby rescinded.
5. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

Read a third time and finally passed April 24, 1989
