STAFF RECOMMENDATION

THAT Council receive the report entitled "Deseronto Fitness Centre"

FURTHER THAT Council authorize the Fitness Centre to re-open effective November 1

Monday-Thursday 5:00p.m-9:30p.m,

Friday 3:00p.m-8:00p.m,

Saturday and Sunday 9:00a.m-2:00p.m and

closed on Statutory Holidays.

FURTHER THAT Council approve a monthly fee of 50% of regular monthly membership fees while the facility is under reduced operation hours.

AND FURTHER THAT Council direct management to bring a project plan back to council with controlled access to the facility, entrance/exit monitoring solution, sample contract/waiver and facility monitoring options during times when the building is not staffed.

BACKGROUND

The Deseronto Recreation Community Centre has a fitness centre on the second floor of the building. This facility has not been open since April 2023 as the Town looks to review staffing and operations of the facility.

Presently, the Deseronto Recreation Community Centre is staffed 1-hour before daily ice rentals and 1-hour after last rental. During this time, there is at least 1 staff member (typically 2) on site.

Council has requested a recommendation/plan from Management on the Hours of Operation and guidelines for the Fitness Centre

OVERVIEW/ANALYSIS

The Deseronto Fitness Centre consists of 20 pieces of Mechanical Fitness equipment, 1 squat rack along with other various fitness devices (mats, bands, board etc.)

Patrons of the facility are required to purchase a monthly membership and utilise a key fob for the second-floor doors to gain access to the fitness centre. Members are able to utilise the facility at their own risk and Town staff provide the janitorial for the Fitness Centre room and changerooms.

The Fitness centre is accessible by way of Stairs or by assistance in the Facility's lift assist device which requires Town Staff assistance.

Phase 1- Soft Opening

Presently, the facility is staffed and the Fitness Centre could open daily at hours that the Municipality has rentals and staff in the facility.

Staff are on-site regularly for the entire season (Present to March):

Monday – Thursday 5:00p.m- 9:30

Friday - 3:00p.m-8:00p.m

Saturday Sunday 9:00a.m-2: 00p.m

Staff would be required to complete regular janitorial and make routine inspection while on site to ensure that there are no health and safety concerns.

Also, Ammonia detection sensory equipment requires "check" prior to allowing entrance of individuals into the facility and the fire alarms in the building require activation to allow for two exits from the facility.

Phase 2 – Expansion of Hours

Under the current construction project, there was intent to accommodate a direct Fitness Centre entrance utilizing the north entrance to the back stairway of the fitness centre. This has since been negated as the facility would not have two exits and would be required to enter the community centre building to utilize the second exit. There is also no hard surface walkway to this door and might be best served as an emergency exit (current use)

There has been communicated desire by members of the community to extend the access to the fitness centre. The fitness centre has not demonstrated itself to be busy enough to warrant full time staffing but consideration of self access to the facility while

mitigating any possible damage or vandalism to property may be an alternative. Of consideration would be to transition to an "Anytime Fitness" Model. At first glance, the considerations and/or alterations that would be required would include the following:

Access:

• A key Fob entry to the North Entrance of Main doors of the recreation community.

Security monitoring/vandalism:

• Re-pointing and strategically locating cameras on the entrances/exits, in the lobby and in the Fitness centre for security purposes. (These would be linked to Monitoring of Town hall and accessible for investigation purposes.

Limiting access and exposure to the rest of the building:

• Installing further devices (similar to the accordion "cage") to limit access past the canteen or beyond the back hallway into the Arena portion of the building.

Other building alterations needed:

- Ensuring alarm and sensor devices are active and have power backup for the Ammonia detection system in the Arena portion of the facility.
- Reconfiguring our Exit and Entrance Doors of the Fitness centre to <u>not</u> be linked to the Fire Alarm System

These alterations may be able to have a portion of the funds allocated towards the initiative through the construction grant (if budget permits). The funds that were intended to be used on the North side may be repurposed to facilitate an amended plan.

As part of the increased access, it would be suggested that the Town would increase their contract and waiver process to a contract/term that would indicate that the facility is not supervised at certain times and that users/patrons are at their own risk outside of supervised hours (similar to Anytime Fitness).

As part of the re-opening program, it is recommended to implement a membership fee at 50% of the previously endorsed fee schedule due to limited hours of availability.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The present financial impact of a "soft opening" is 0. There is no budgetary expense aside from increased janitorial responsibilities.

Each year the Town of Deseronto receives an allotment from the Province of Ontario under the Ontario Municipal Partnership Fund (OMPF). BY-LAW XX-2023

BEING A BY-LAW TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ONTARIO CLEAN WATER AGENCY (OCWA) TO PROVIDE WATER AND SEWAGE SERVICES TO THE TOWN OF DESERONTO

WHEREAS the Ontario Municipal Act 2001, Section 224(a) provides that it is the role of the Council to represent the public and to consider the well-being and interests of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Ontario Clean Water Agency wishes to continue providing service to the Town of Deseronto until October 31, 2028;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Deseronto has acknowledged that they wish to enter into an Agreement;

AND WHEREAS the terms and conditions of this Services Agreement made as of the 1st day of November, 2023 are described in this agreement which is attached hereto as Schedule "A".

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deseronto enacts as follows:

BEING A BY-LAW TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE MOHAWKS OF THE BAY OF QUINTE TO ALLOW THE MOHAWKS OF THE BAY OF QUINTE TO CONNECT TO DESERONTO INFRASTRUCTURE

WHEREAS the Ontario Municipal Act 2001, Section 224(a) provides that it is the role of the Council to represent the public and to consider the well-being and interests of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS The Town of Deseronto owns and operates a municipal water and sewer system within the boundaries of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS The Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte wish to connect to the Deseronto infrastructure on Brant and Mill Streets;

AND WHEREAS The Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte will carry out the Project in accordance with any applicable federal and/or provincial regulatory processes and/or permitting requirements, as those prescribed by Deseronto;

AND WHEREAS both parties wish to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding attached.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deseronto enacts as follows:
