A complete bag tag must be attached to each garbage bag to ensure pick-up. Tags can be purchased for \$2.00 each from the Town Hall and participating convenience/grocery stores.

Town of Deseronto Acceptable Recyclable Items for Pick-Up

Paper/Cardboard Products

Glass/Metal/Plastic Products



Acceptable Items

(All paper and cardboard must be clean)

- Newspaper, flyers, magazines and catalogues
- Corrugated cardboard
- Telephone books
- Cereal and cracker boxes (liners removed)
- Shoe and laundry detergent boxes
- Fine paper such as writing paper, computer paper, paper pads, advertising mail, envelopes
- Hard and soft cover books (binding removed)
- Paper egg cartons, toilet paper and paper towel rolls
- Clean craft paper or brown packaging
- Frozen dinner boxes
- Pizza boxes (no pizza please!)
- Frozen concentrate cans

Your box should not weigh more than fifteen (15) kg when full.
Flatten for improved space and bundle cardboard no larger than 36' X 24" X 8"



Acceptable Items

(All glass/metal/plastic products must be rinsed clean)

Glass

- Bottles and jars (lids off)

Metal

- Metal / aluminum cans / lids e.g. food & soft drink cans
- Aluminum containers & Clean foil
- Spiral-wound canisters with metal ends (frozen concentrate cans, Pringles container)

Plastic

Acceptable plastics: Polyethylene Terephthalate (PETE#1), High Density Polyethylene (HDPE #2), Low Density Polyethylene (LDPE #4), Polypropylene (PP #5) and Polystyrene (PS #6), which previously contained a non-hazardous consumer product.

- Plastic bottles, jars, tubs and jugs
- Clean plastic bags / Rinsed Milk Bags / Bread Bags / Frozen Food Bags / Dry Cleaning Bags
- Drink, soup, juice and milk boxes/cartons

Your box should not weigh more than fifteen (15) kg when full.
Return empty LCBO bottles for refund to Beer Store - Empty Bottle Dealer.



Unacceptable Items

(Place these items in your regular garbage)

- Waxed paper or cardboard
- Cereal and cracker box liners, chip and cookie bags and canisters
- Chocolate bar and candy wrappings
- Wooden Clementine and orange crates
- Foil or Paper wrapping paper, bows, ribbons
- Plastic of any kind
- Paper and cardboard lined with foil
- Fast food drink cups
- Tissues (nothing from the bathroom please!)
- NO ITEMS heavily soiled with food or containing food
- Items that should be in your BLUE BOX Collection



Unacceptable Items

(Place these items in your regular garbage)

Glass

- Ceramics such as dishes, cups and pottery
- Glass such as drinking glasses, window glass, light bulbs incl. fluorescent, and mirrors, broken glass, mirrors

Metal

- Food contaminated foil & bags
- Aerosol cans
- Metal clothes hangers & scrap metal

Plastic

- Styrofoam containers or Styrofoam packaging
- No food plastic wrap or bags e.g. packaging from meat, cheese, cereal/snack foods
- Hard plastics such as dishes, cups, toys, make-up jars, plastic buckets, laundry baskets
- Motor oil bottles
